

High School Scrimmage at the BNCC

- The BNCC is located at 425 Meyer Rd in West Seneca, NY 14224
- Courts will be available for shared warm-up at 5:00pm. Keep in mind that there are 4 teams per court.
- Play will begin at 5:30pm. Time slots will be 20 minutes in length. (JV Boys will be 45minutes) Time will be kept on a countdown clock. Coaches should meet to discuss what drills and or scrimmage format they wish to use for their 20 minute period.
- Teams MAY be OFF the court between periods. **Please plan to have team meetings or team activities that can be done in the balcony or lobby area.** Teams may bring video cameras if desired. The BNCC has two TV's available for camera viewing when available. Please coordinate the need for TV usage with BNCC staff prior to the event.
- Tables may be pushed together and dry erase boards may be used when available.
- No school competition uniforms are to be worn.
- Score will only be kept by and for the training of officials or scorekeepers.
- There will be unlimited time outs and substitutions. Coaches may stop play and enter the court to coach.
- No records of wins/losses will be kept, and no winning or losing scores are counted in any record.



- The NYSPHSAA Handbook says:
12. INTERSCHOOL SCRIMMAGE/PRACTICE SESSIONS: A scrimmage is an interschool practice session. In practice sessions/scrimmages: (a) both squads use the same field simultaneously with both coaches making corrections and giving instructions to players as they would during their own practice, (b) no official score is kept, (c) no definite time is set for scrimmage periods, (d) no admission is charged, (e) no spectators are permitted unless such is the usual plan whenever the squad has a practice. The use of officials would be permitted and encouraged whenever possible for the purpose of instruction regarding the rules and proper application of rules.
- There are to be at least 6 team practices and the individual must have participated in 4 of those before there may be a scrimmage.
