BNCC Whiteout – Tournament Rules

Matches: Matches in ROUND 1 will be best 2 sets to 25, with no cap. 14s Pool B will play 2 sets to 25 with the score starting at 4 (21 point sets). All PLAYOFF matches will be best 2/3 sets to 25 points with the deciding game to 15 points if necessary.

Work teams (pool play): each work team must supply at least 5 workers, including a down-official, a score keeper, a libero-tracker / score flipper, and two line-judges. A team coach must be courtside when their team is working. Work teams will be docked one point for every minute they are late. If they are more than 25 minutes late, they will forfeit their entire next match.

Work teams (playoffs): Teams that lose in the playoffs will have to immediately work on the court they just played unless otherwise noted. Work teams in the playoffs may find a replacement work team so that they can travel home first ONLY if approved by the tournament director. Failure to work a playoff game will result in additional charges to enter future BNCC / NFVB tournaments.

Warm-ups: For a team's first match of the day, 2-4-4 (2 minutes shared court time for ball handling, 4 minutes for the serving team, and 4 minutes for the receiving team). For the rest of the matches (including playoffs), there will be a 1-3-3 format. Please try to hit away from spectator seating.

Tie Breakers: Teams tied in set win/loss record competing to enter the Gold Bracket will play one 15 point playoff game. All other ties will be broken by head-to-head set win/loss record, then head to head point differential, then total pool play point differential, then coin toss called by highest seed. If ties exist between the third place teams across pools, the team with the highest overall pool play point differential advances as the top seeded 3rd place team. That team will ref a one 15 point playoff game between the other tied teams to see who advances to the Gold Playoff Bracket.

Protests: All protests will be settled during that point in the match. A protest may not occur after the next point has begun. Protests will be handled by the tournament director (or designee) and the head official (or designee). A protest cannot be made on a judgment call.

Other Rules:

- Liberos will be allowed to serve in one of the rotation positions.
- Awards will only be given to the winner and runner-up of the Gold Bracket
